

# WARMING HOMELESS CENTER AT NORTPOINT



The City of Tacoma opened a Warming Center at Norpoint in response to the emergency related to homelessness during the COVID-19 pandemic. The warming Center serves up to 25 adult women and couples by reservation only, no walk-in service available. It started operations at the end of January, running through February 28, 2021. Participants are referred and transported to and from the center through city services where they receive 24-hour shelter and connected with additional supportive services. Sleeping mats, showers, face coverings and meals are provided for all guests by the onsite operator — Valeo Vocation. Program participants and onsite staff must wear masks, maintain physical distancing, and follow all other required safety measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19.


